

School FAQs

Are there any requirements for the size or style of our school angel?

We trust that as it will be transported to the church, it will not be excessively huge as one among others in the church. Otherwise, no restrictions what so ever! You may use any art medium, and produce one model angel or a display of angels.

Angels that are entered competitively by individuals and small groups are required to have a name or title and to include somewhere on them a Bible verse. It would fit in nicely to the spirit of the event for your school angel also to have both these, but it is not necessary. Note: you will find a number of Bible references that mention angels here on this website.

Can we advertise our school through our angel?

By all means! In fact, if the angel itself does not identify which school it is from then we would like you to make a sign to put next to the angel to say who has made it.

We would like to make more than one angel. Is that allowed?

We are very flexible to receive whatever your school wants to bring and we do not anticipate a problem of space provided the angels are within sensible proportions!

Does our angel need to be brought to the church?

If you would specifically prefer to register your angel for a trail at an alternative location (presumably the school site) then you are welcome to do so (choose a category and follow the registration process). However, we have invited all schools to bring their angel into the church for a display there and we are anticipating 20-25 'school angels'.

When should we bring our angel to church?

We will be open to receiving angels on Thursday 1st May 1pm – 5pm and on Friday 2nd May 9.30am – 3pm. If your angel and/or angel display requires you to set it up in position then please bring it on Friday when it's location within the church can be decided. If you are happy for us to put your angel in a display position then please do make use of the Thursday delivery time if you prefer.

What do we do when we arrive at the church with our angel?

The school angel display will be upstairs in the main body of the church. The old door towards the west end (on Kirkby Road) is at the upstairs level and once in the outside door, turn left and enter through another large door. If you enter the church at the east end (Church Lane) you will go down a ramp or steps to enter into the vestibule of our meeting room area and you would then need to ascend the stairs to your left to get into the main body of the church. Both points of entry will be open at delivery times.

Can we have our angel back afterwards?

By all means! We would be glad if you would collect your angel at the following times: Immediately after the Monday afternoon prize-giving event which begins at 3pm and should last until approximately 4.30pm OR Tuesday 6th May 9.00am – 1.30pm and 4pm – 5pm. If your angel is not collected or an alternative arrangement made, we may have to dispose of it after the event.
